Use the spinner templates below to actively involve students in your lessons. Create one per team or table. It will assist in randomly selecting students to:

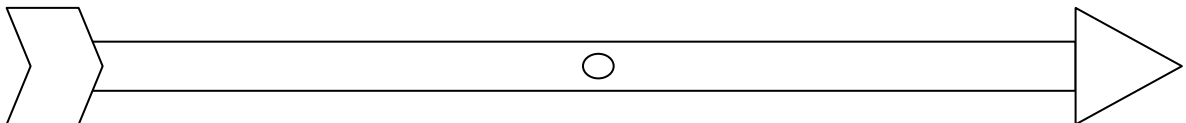
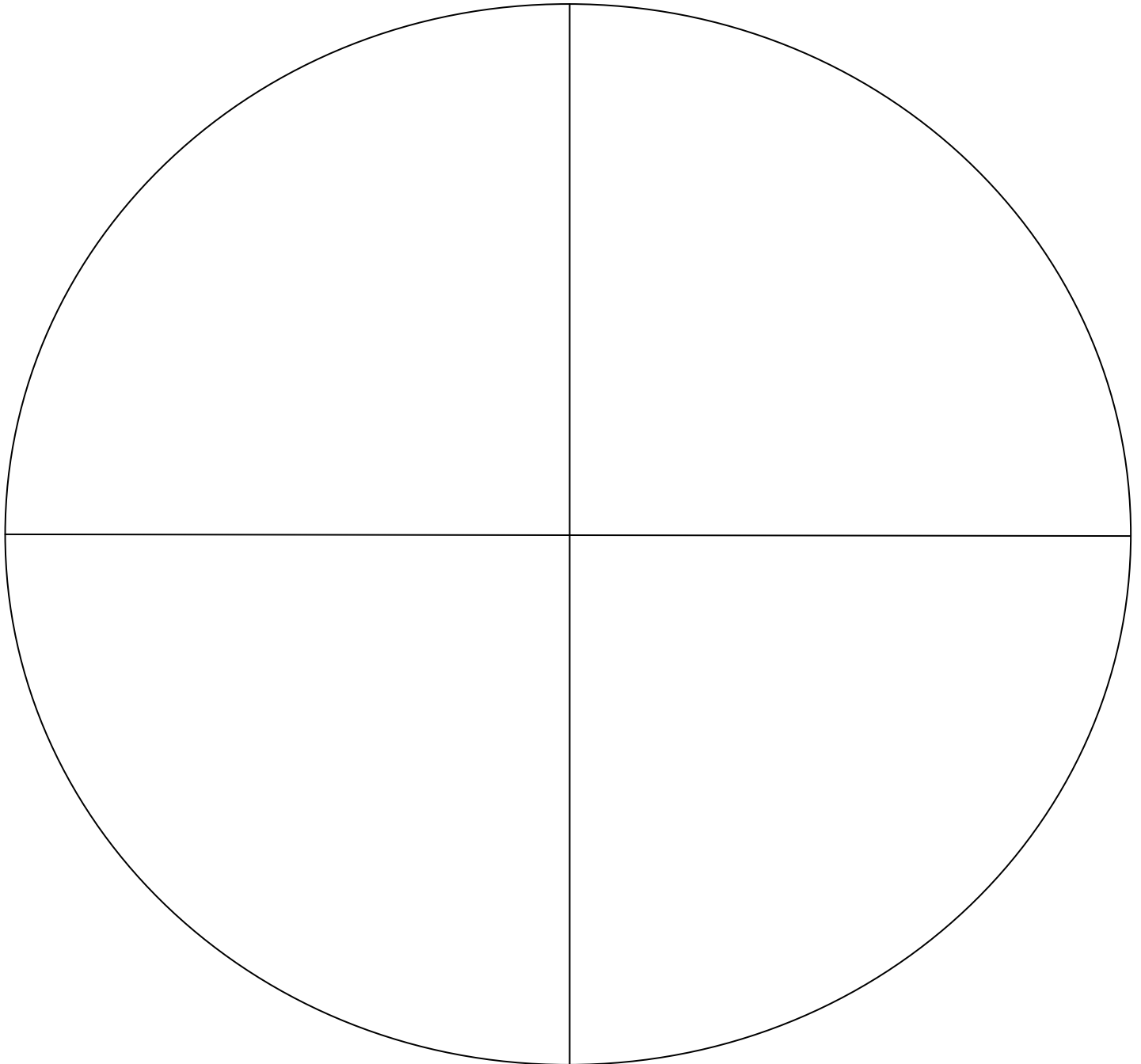
- read or answer questions

Template for Spinner #1

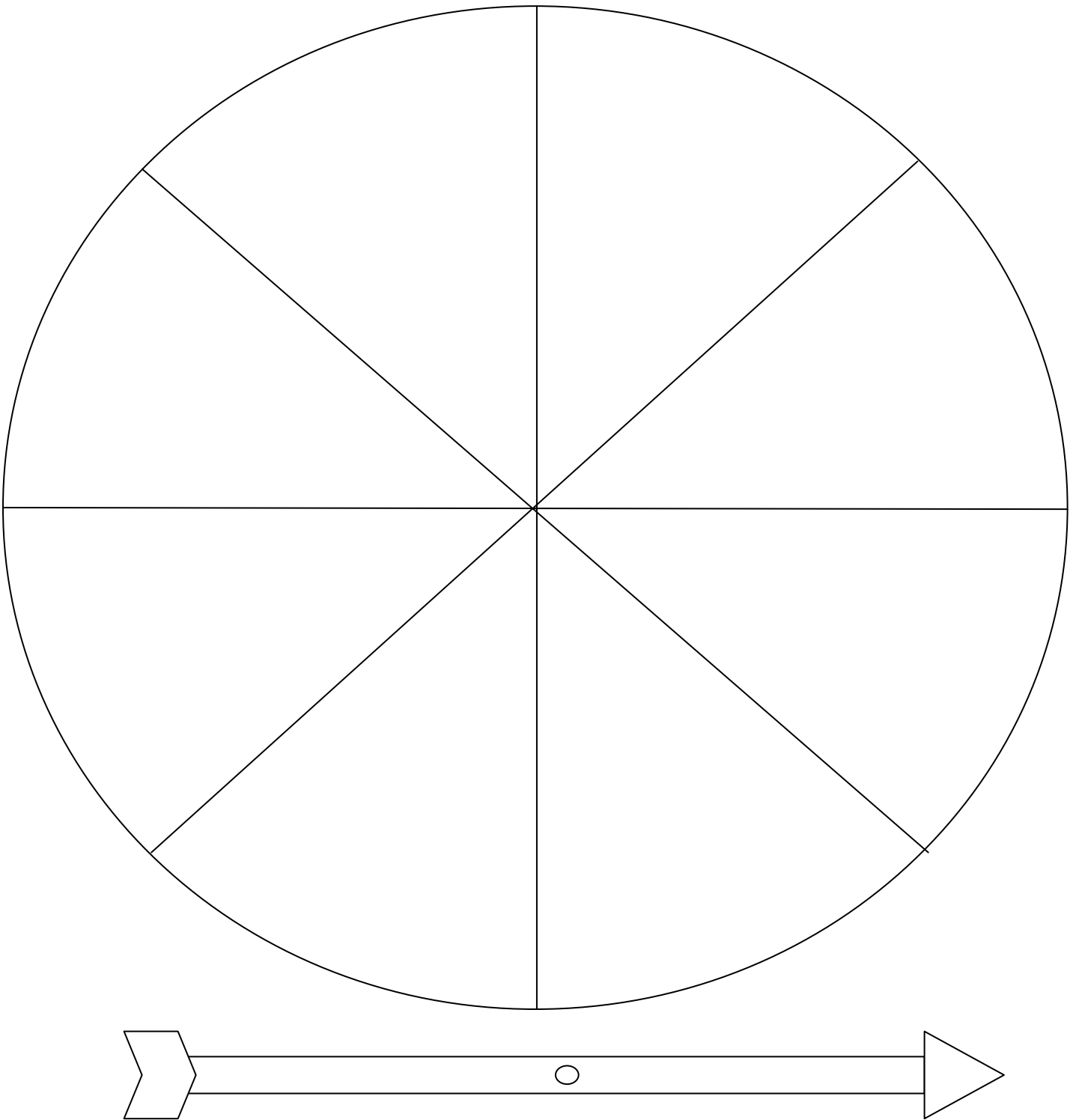

Template for Spinner #2

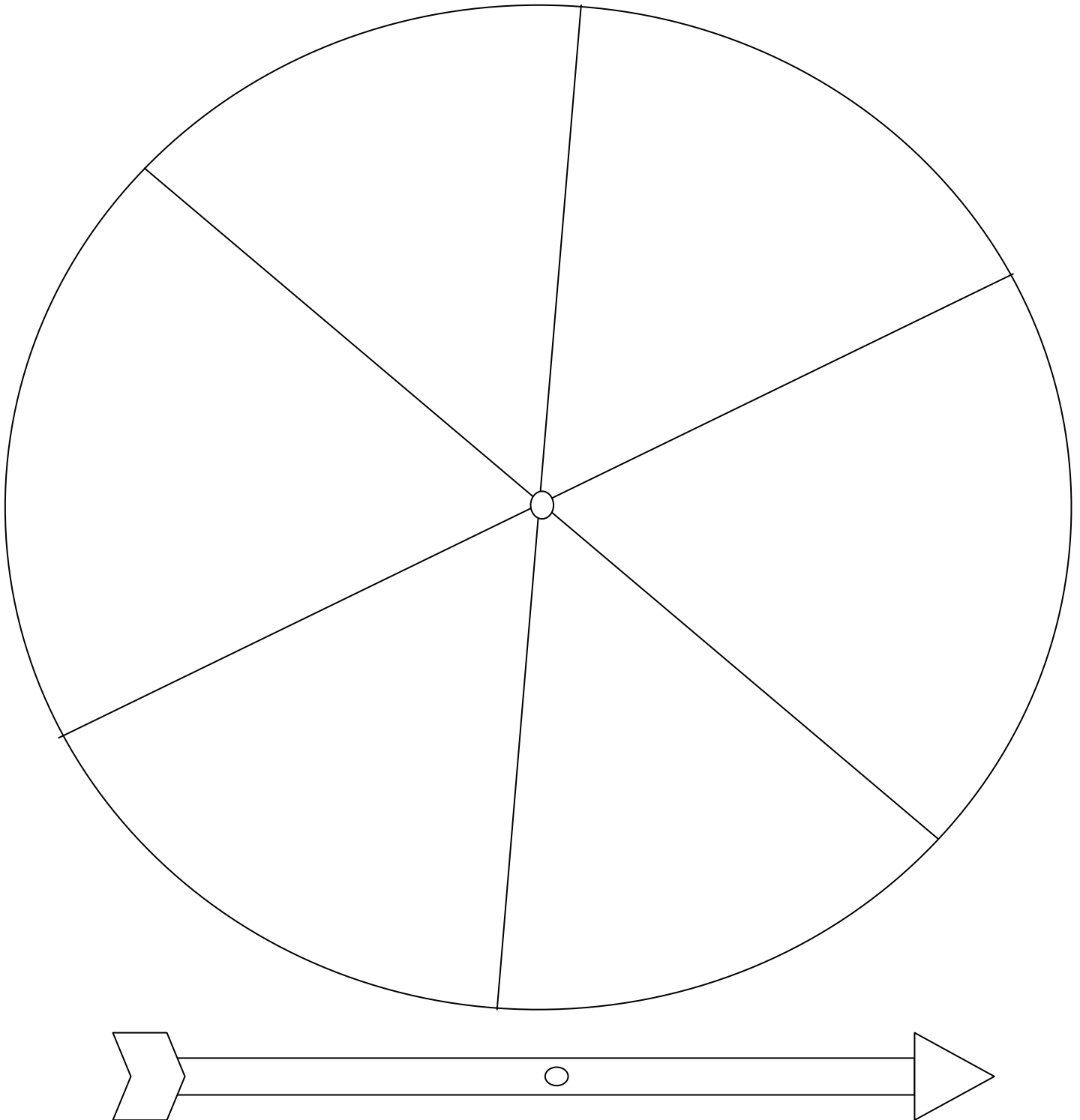
